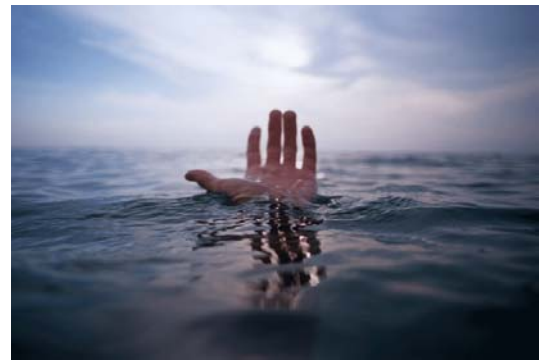


Surrendering to God
